

Notes on symbols.

- 1) SYKS at the top of all pages means
ஸாதி வழக்டுவார் தினை மாதிரி (SYKS).
So SYKS-AI means SYKS சாதியுசூலி
- 2) + is to indicate that 1st consonant of the next கிடைக்கும்போ கிடைக்கும்போ should be stressed while chanting.
- 3) FP is to indicate the sound of visargam appearing before ஸ்-related words.
Eg அநா: ஸ்ரி → அநா: ^{FP} ஸ்ரி
- 4) HK is to indicate the sound of visargam appearing before ஹ்-related words.
Eg வெங்கு: கிளை → வெங்கு: ^{HK} கிளை
- 5) single vertical above a syllable is to indicate that it should be pronounced with a stress.
- 6) underline is to lower the pitch
- 7) Double vertical is to indicate raising the pitch and to elongate the syllable while chanting.
- 8) l symbol is to indicate that the syllable should be chanted in a pitch and elongation between single vertical and double verticals.
- 9) The numbers like $\frac{1}{3.30}$ shows the track number and time as per IISHT audio in internet
